Motorcycling in Mongolia is the best way to experience the wilderness and rich culture of a truly ancient and amazing land.

At the same time, motorcycling has its dangers, especially with unpredictable traffic and quick-changing weather conditions. Our Mongolian tours are perhaps better termed motorcycle expeditions, and should be undertaken by fit, experienced riders with an open mind for changing road conditions and different rules of the road.

Note our tours are not suitable for novices, we do offer beginner's tours for details please contact us at info@outback-mongolia.com.

As an adventure tour itineraries, accommodation and routes may have to be changed due to local conditions, for example depending on seasons rivers may run deeper forcing a route change.

Price includes:

All hotels, ger camp lodgings (including bedding) and camping equipment in Mongolia

Meals, motorcycle and fuel, support/Luggage van, mechanic, tour guide on motorcycle (minimum numbers required), some museum entrance fees, tour souvenir and airport transfers.

Price excludes:

International flights to/from Ulaan Baatar or Beijing , travel insurance, tips, drinks, camel trek and any other optional activities, visas.

Medical. We strongly recommend you have current vaccinations for polio and typhoid.

Temperatures.

Summer temperatures in Mongolia are similar to the Europe with ranges from low 20's to high 20s. Rainfall in Mongolia can result in muddy, difficult tracks. While riding you must be prepared for these changes. Altitude can play a factor a warm sunny day can become a cold night at 2600 meters so a warm coat is a must.

Age restrictions.

18-85, but please check with us if you are over 65, we can be flexible.

Visas.

Visas are required and can be obtained in the UK for both Mongolia and China, allow £60/p for a visa to China or Mongolia.

Please note that if you are traveling to and from Mongolia via Beijing China that a double entry visa will be required.
